- 3. Read Genesis 2:4-25. What distinguishes mankind from animals according to this passage?
- 4. What were your initial thoughts toward the end of the message when Pastor John told men, "It's time to rule"?
- 5. Adam's identity is connected to God's identity, how does this influence our understanding of "ruling"?
- 6. Read 1 Thessalonians 4:1-9 aloud in your group and then have each person take a few moments to read it to themselves underlining something that stands out to them. Share what was underlined and why.
- 7. How does 1 Thessalonians 4:1-9 speak to ruling over ourselves?
- 8. How does this passage impact our relationships with others?
- 9. Although these may look different for each person, most people have times of struggling with temper, temptations and a tendency to walk away. Which one would you say has had the biggest impact on your relationships?
- 10. Which one do you feel God might be calling you to take "rulership" over and address first?
- 11. Which one—temper, temptation or tendency to walk away—do you need to own up to and apologize for?
- 12. Pastor John stated, "When we know who we are we can begin to do life and relationships really well." What steps will you take this week to walk in the identity God has given you?
