- 7. Read Ephesians 1:15-23. What parallels do you see between this passage and 1 Peter 1:1-12?
- 8. Paul prays "that they eyes of your heart may be enlightened". How can you partner with God to pursue this heart change?
- 9. What things bring the most comfort or hope during times of suffering and challenge?
- 10. How does the life, death and resurrection of Jesus impact your understanding of your own suffering and the hope that you have? Are there any areas where you feel like it doesn't have a real impact?
- 11. What can you do this week to strengthen your hope in Jesus or spread hope to others?
