



## Huddle

Luke 6:12-16: One of those days Jesus went out on a mountainside to pray, and spent the night praying to God. 13 When morning came, he called his disciples to him and chose twelve of them, whom he designated apostles: 14 Simon (who he named Peter), his brother Andrew, James, John, Philip, Bartholomew, 15 Matthew, Thomas, James son of Alphaeus, Simon who was called the Zealot, 16 Judas son of James, and Judas Iscariot, who became a traitor.

Matthew 16:23: Jesus turned and said to Peter, "Get behind me, Satan!"

Luke 9:54-55: When the disciples James and John saw this, they asked, "Lord, do you want us to call fire down from heaven to destroy them?" 55 But Jesus turned and rebuked them.

Acts 12:2: He had James, the brother of John, put to death with the sword.

John 6:7: Philip answered him, "It would take more than half a year's wages to buy enough bread for each one to have a bite!"

John 14:8: Philip said, "Lord, show us the Father and that will be enough for us."

John 1:46: "Nazareth! Can anything good come from there?" Nathanael asked.

John 1:49: Then Nathanael declared, "Rabbi, you are the Son of God; you are the king of Israel."

Matthew 9:9: As Jesus went on from there, he saw a man named Matthew sitting at the tax collector's booth...

John 20:25: So the other disciples told him, "We have seen the Lord!" But [Thomas] said to them, "Unless I see the nail marks in his hands and put my finger where the nails were, and put my hand into his side, I will not believe."

John 11:16: Then Thomas (also known as Didymus) said to the rest of the disciples, "Let us also go, that we may die with him."

Mark 15:40 ...Mary the mother of James the younger...

Matthew 10:3 (KJV): ...Lebbaeus, whose surname was Thaddaeus.

Matthew 15:16: "Are you still so dull?" Jesus asked them.

Luke 9:46: An argument started among the disciples as to which of them was the greatest.

Matthew 8:26: He replied, "You of little faith..."
