- 1. What stood out to you from this week's message? Why?
- 2. Read Colossians 1:15-20. How would you sum up what these verses claim about Jesus?
- 3. What titles and descriptions of Jesus do you find in 1:15-20?
- 4. Which titles or descriptions do you feel have the biggest impact or are most applicable to your life?
- 5. How was—and is—Jesus supreme in creation (vv. 15-17)?
- 6. How was—and is—Jesus supreme in redemption (vv. 18-20)?
- 7. Read Hebrews 1:1-4. What parallels do these verses have with those in Colossians 1:15-20? (John 1:1-5 provides another parallel)
- 8. In weeks one and two, the discussion focused on faithfulness to Jesus and the hope that is found in the kingdom of Jesus. How do the passages in Colossians 1:15-20 and Hebrews 1:1-4 provide the foundation for faithfulness and hope?
- 9. What are the implications of the centrality and supremacy of Jesus for your daily life, in the home, at work or at church?
- 10. Paul isn't just concerned with believing in Jesus' supremacy, but with how Jesus' supremacy influences and directs your daily life. How would your life look different if you gave Jesus the place of preeminence or supremacy?
- 11. When you think of giving Jesus supremacy over your life where do you feel the most tension or apprehension?
- 12. Try to identify a couple of areas where Jesus is not supreme, maybe those areas where following Jesus' value, virtues and life have not yet taken root.
