3. Read Matthew 5:38-42. The phrase "turn the other cheek" may be familiar. Do you feel that it has the same meaning today as it did in Jesus' time?
4. Why would someone turn the other cheek? What benefit does it have or what results are intended?
5. In what ways does prioritizing reputation, rights and resources affect our relationships? These are not inherently bad, so what causes them to become negative factors in our life?
6. Read Matthew 16:24-26. What are some ways to understand the phrase "lose one's life for Jesus"?
7. Finding one's life in Jesus takes intentionality and denial of self. What are some ways that you can grow in your reliance on him?
8. How does the metaphor in John 15:4-5 relate to our dependence and reliance on Jesus?
9. While 3-minutes a day can begin to rewire our brains, what would it look like to be more consistently aware of Jesus throughout the day?
10. What are some things you can do to increase your awareness of those times where your reputation, rights and resources (or the pursuit of these) take precedence over a right treatment of others?
11. Where do you need to see growth in this area? Share with the group and take time to pray together.
