- 7. Can you identify one or more times that you felt the strength that the Psalmist speaks of here?
- 8. When you go through hard times, what practical ways do you get strength from God?
- 9. Psalm 84 talks of going to the house of God, not long after this was written God promised that his presence would dwell in us. What does it mean for God's spirit to dwell in us?
- 10. Read Luke 24:46-49. What power is Jesus speaking of and what difference does it make for those who follow Jesus? (consider also Romans 8:9-11)
- 11. How does seeing yourself as the place where God dwells change your interactions with others? (2 Corinthians 5:20)
- 12. How can you show others the love and presence of God?
- 13. What stands in the way of you being a person who brings others into the house of God?
