- 2. What do you think of A.J. Swaboda's quote, "To struggle with your faith is often the surest sign that you have one"?
- 3. In what periods of your life have you experienced the greatest struggles with faith?
- 4. Read Genesis 2-3. What do you discover about God's character in these verses?
- 5. Where do you see God's provision in Genesis 2-3?
- 6. Pastor Brian asked the question, "How do you hear God in this text? What tone does He have?" How have you typically pictured or "heard" God in this narrative?
- 7. How does your view of God influence how you see God in this passage? Can you identify two or three things that influence your picture of God?
- 8. Read Romans 5:12-21? This is a rather dense passage, take your time as you read it and identify the comparisons between Adam and Christ that the passage makes.
- 9. Why is this passage significant for our understanding of Jesus?
- 10. How does God remain faithful despite humanity's failures? How does seeing God as faithful provide a path forward through failure?
- 11. Is there an area of your life where you feel like the struggle never ends, or characterized by failure more than success?
- 12. Do you have a perspective of God that could be keeping you stuck in your failure rather than experiencing his "abundant provision of grace and life" (Romans 5:17)?
