- Thinking back over the past week, what words have stuck—positively or negatively—with you most?
- 3. When have you been surprised by the influence of your words on others?
- 4. Read James 3:1-12. As you read, what do you discover about the tongue (i.e. our words)?
- 5. When you read this passage, is there anything that you wish the author would have included or provided clarity on? How would this help?
- 6. Would you have put such a dramatic point, using such strong language, on the nature of the tongue? Why or why not?
- 7. What do you think of James' point that "no one can tame the tongue"?
- 8. How does James' point impact your perspective on the tongue or your attempt to gain control over your words?
- 9. James 1:5 instructs us to ask God for wisdom. What role does wisdom have with our words?
- 10. Have you ever been able to slow down your speech—to pause—and avoid a verbal disaster (James 1:19)? What helped you be successful? What causes you to be unsuccessful?
- 11. Try to summaries each of the three steps: Pause, Surrender, and Pour. Where in the process do you often get stuck or is there a piece that you often skip?
- 12. What is one thing you have taken away from this series that you feel God calling you to focus on?
